Risk Factors Orphans Face



59 Million

An estimated 59 million children of primary-school age are not in school.



3 Months

Development is delayed by 3 months for every year spent in an institution.



20 IQ Points

Children raised in orphanages have an IQ 20 points lower than their peers in foster care.



1.2 Million

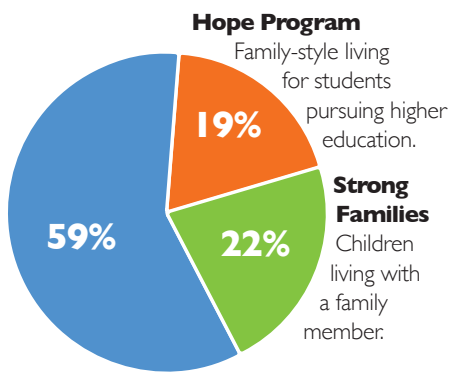
1.2 million children are trafficked each year. Orphans are 'easy targets'



Research shows the best place for a child is in a healthy home with their biological family. To help families stay together, Back2Back comes alongside parents in our Strong Families Program to provide resources and training to help keep children with their biological parents. Back2Back also works to reunify children in institutions with their families whenever possible. For a variety of reasons, and because each situation is different, sometimes an institution is the best place for a child.

What does holistic care look like?

There are many experiences that occur naturally in family life that orphaned and vulnerable children miss out on. To reduce this gap, Back2Back strives to provide deep, holistic care and family-style living at the children's homes we serve, and programs to empower parents with the hope of reuniting families. This is achieved in part, through Child Sponsorship by providing things like:



Consistency

Consistent caregivers trained to help children heal from past trauma show children they are seen and known.



Field Trips

Field trips to local landmarks, restaurants, and parks expand worldviews and teach social skills.



Education

Sponsorship dollars help afford a tutor at each home to ensure children are provided a well-rounded education.



Encouragement

Relationship and letters from sponsors show children they are loved and not forgotten, and encourage them as they grow and mature.
